



Find the installer program, either on the CDROM or the Website.

Copy or download the file to your desktop.

Using your mouse, right click on the installer program and select properties.



Choose the Compatibility Tab, check the box labeled "Run this program in compatibility mode for" and pick "Windows 2000" from the list box.



Click OK.

Now double click the installer icon and follow the steps to install your software. When the installation is done, right click on theDakView icon and select "Run as Administrator"


Troubleshooting USB issues:

Right click on My Computer and click on "Manage"

In the left window pane, click of Device Manager.

Expand the "Ports" line using the + sign next to "Ports"

You should see an entry fo the USB adapter cable:



This also tells you which port it is connected to. You must enter this port in Settings -> Com Port.
